This list is only a guide and we encourage you to research and test your gear, especially your boots, before arriving in Tanzania.

#### EQUIPMENT

- □ 1 down sleeping bag (rated to a least 18°F / -7°C)
- □ 1 trekking poles, collapsible (highly recommended)
- □ 1 head lamp, with extra batteries
- 🗆 1 duffel Bag, 90 liter, for porters to carry your equipment

□ 1 day-pack, 30-35L, for you to carry personal gear (you may wish to get a Camelback type that carries water in a bladder).

#### **TECHNICAL CLOTHING**

- □ 1 waterproof jacket, breathable with hood
- 1 insulated jacket, synthetic or down
- □ 1 soft jacket, fleece or soft-shell
- □ 2 long sleeve shirt, moisture-wicking fabric
- □ 1 short sleeve shirt, moisture-wicking fabric
- □ 1 waterproof pants, breathable
- 2 hiking pants / convertible (into shorts)
- □ 1 fleece pants
- □ 1 shorts (optional)
- □ 1 long underwear, moisture-wicking fabric
- □ 3 underwear, moisture-wicking fabric
- 2 sport bra (women)

## ACCESSORIES

- □ 1 sunglasses full coverage / goggles
- □ 1 camp towel, quick drying
- □ 1 backpack cover, waterproof (optional)
- □ 1 water bottle (Nalgene, 32 oz.)
- 1 water bladder (Camelback type, 3 liters)
- □ 1 Pee Bottle (to avoid leaving tent at night)

stuff sacks, dry bags or Zip lock bags, various sizes to keep gear dry and separate

## HEADWEAR

- □ 1 brimmed hat or cap for sun protection
- □ 1 bandana (optional)
- □ 1 knit hat, for warmth
- □ 1 balaclava or buff, for face coverage (optional)

## HANDWEAR

- □ 1 gloves, thin
- □ 1 gloves, warm (waterproof recommended)

# FOOTWEAR

- □ 1 hiking boots, warm, waterproof, broken-in
- □ 1 shoes / flip flops (to wear at camp, optional)
- □ 1 shoelaces, extra
- □ 3 socks, wool or synthetic
- □ 1 gaiters, waterproof (optional)

# OTHER

- □toiletries
- □ quick dry towel
- prescriptions malaria tablets, Diamox (optional)
- □ sunscreen, SPF 30+
- □ lip balm, SPF 30+
- □ insect repellent, containing DEET
- 🗆 first aid kit
- □ painkillers (optional)
- □ blister kit (optional)
- anti-diarrhea tablets (optional)
- □ hand sanitizer
- toilet paper
- □ Wet Wipes (recommended)
- □ snacks, lightweight, high calorie (optional)
- electrolytes, powder or tablets (optional)
- camera, with extra batteries (optional)
- power bank, solar panel, spare batteries (optional)

#### PAPERWORK

- passport (valid for + 6 months <u>after</u> your trip)
- visa, available at JRO (pay in cash)
- □ immunization papers
- medical insurance
- □ travel Insurance
- □ cash for tips, visa and incidentals
